At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows: 1 $\mathbf{2}$ **1.** Page 1, line 1: delete "employees" and substitute "employees and the 3 unemployment insurance waiting period". 4 **2.** Page 1, line 2: before that line insert: $\mathbf{5}$ "SECTION 1n. 108.04 (3) (b) of the statutes, as affected by 2021 Wisconsin Act 6 4, is amended to read: 7 108.04 (3) (b) Paragraph (a) does not apply with respect to benefit years that 8 begin after March 12, 2020, and before March 14 September 5, 2021. The 9 department shall seek the maximum amount of federal reimbursement for benefits that are, during the time period specified in this paragraph, payable for the first 10 week of a claimant's benefit year as a result of the application of this paragraph.". 11 12(END)
