| 9 | "(3) LIMITATIONS. (a) An individual may not provide services or obtain a |
| 10 | preliminary health care credential under this section if the individual has ever been |
| 11 | convicted of any of the following: |
| 12 | 1. A felony. |

2. A misdemeanor, the circumstances of which involved the individual causing
 bodily harm to, or having sexual contact with, another individual.

(b) Notwithstanding ss. 111.321, 111.322, and 111.335, par. (a) applies
regardless of whether the conviction is a conviction based upon which the
department or credentialing board, as applicable, may deny the individual's
application for a permanent health care credential or training health care credential
under sub. (2) (a) 1. g.".
