1	At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:
2	${f 1.}$ Page 3, line 14: delete the material beginning with that line and ending with
3	page 4, line 5.
4	2. Page 4, line 13: on lines 13 and 25, after " <u>oral</u> " insert " <u>or written</u> ".
5	3. Page 5, line 6: delete lines 6 to 12.
6	4. Page 6, line 4: after that line insert:
7	"Section 9r. $304.06(1)(d)$ 3. and (e) of the statutes are amended to read:
8	304.06 (1) (d) 3. The notice shall state the name of the inmate, the date, and
9	term of the sentence and the date when the written statement, if written by an office
10	under par. (c) 1. or 2., must be received in order to be considered. If the notice is to
11	an office under par. (c) 1. or 2., the notice shall also state the crime of which the
12	inmate was convicted.

2	3. to provide written statements. The parole commission shall give consideration to
3	any written statements provided by any such <u>an</u> office or person and <u>under par.</u> (c)

5	statements provided by a person under par. (c) 3. whether received before or at the
6	interview or hearing. This paragraph does not limit the authority of the parole
7	commission to consider other statements or information that it receives in a timely
8	fashion.".
