5	municipality to conduct a recount after the election of all absentee ballots cast in the
6	municipality in the election. The commission's order shall establish procedures for
7	the recount consistent with s. 9.01.
8	(e) Absentee ballots canvassed under this subsection may not be processed
9	through automatic tabulating equipment and votes may not be tallied until after the
10	polls close on election day.".
