ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1, TO ASSEMBLY BILL 645

January 10, 2024 - Offered by Representative KRUG.

1 AN ACT *to amend* 59.53 (21) of the statutes; **relating to:** county relief programs.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

2 **SECTION 1.** 59.53 (21) of the statutes is amended to read:

3 59.53 (21) OPERATION OF RELIEF PROGRAMS. The board may establish and operate a program of relief for a specific class or classes of persons residing in that county, 4 5 except that in a county with a population of 750,000 or more, the county executive 6 shall be in charge of the operation of the program of relief. The county may set such 7 eligibility criteria to obtain relief, and may provide such any services, commodities, 8 or money as relief, as that the county determines to be is reasonable and necessary 9 under the circumstances. The county may directly provide relief under this 10 subsection or may provide an appropriation to a nonprofit organization, as defined 11 in s. 23.197 (4) (a) 1., for the purpose of funding a program of relief provided by that nonprofit organization. A relief program under this subsection may include work
components. The county may enact any ordinances necessary or useful to the
operation of a relief program under this subsection. Counties may use vehicle
registration information from the department of transportation in determining
eligibility for relief programs under this subsection.
