



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 3,
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 975**

January 23, 2024 - Offered by Representative ROZAR.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 3, line 2: after that line insert:

3 **“SECTION 3m.** 253.107 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

4 253.107 (2) PROBABLE POSTFERTILIZATION AGE. Except in the case of a medical
5 emergency and except as provided in sub. (3m), no physician may perform or induce
6 an abortion, or attempt to perform or induce an abortion, unless the physician
7 performing or inducing it has first made a determination of the probable
8 postfertilization age of the unborn child or relied upon such a determination made
9 by another physician.”.

10 **2.** Page 3, line 19: after that line insert:

11 **“SECTION 5m.** 253.107 (3) (c) of the statutes is created to read:

12 253.107 (3) (c) No physician who performs a medical intervention designed or
13 intended to prevent the death of a pregnant woman is considered to have violated

1 this section, except that the physician shall make reasonable medical efforts under
2 the circumstances to preserve both the life of the woman and the life of the unborn
3 child in a manner consistent with conventional medical practice as provided in par.
4 (b). Medical treatment provided to the woman by a physician that results in
5 accidental or unintentional injury or death to the unborn child is not a violation of
6 this section.”.

7 **3.** Page 3, line 20: before that line insert:

8 “**SECTION 5r.** 253.107 (3m) of the statutes is created to read:

9 253.107 (**3m**) EXCEPTIONS. This section does not apply to an abortion if the
10 abortion is performed or induced on a pregnant woman whose pregnancy is the result
11 of sexual assault or incest.”.

12 **4.** Page 3, line 25: after “emergency” insert “or if the pregnancy is the result
13 of sexual assault or incest”.

14 **5.** Page 4, line 7: delete “and (b)” and substitute “(b), and (c)”.
