SENATE AMENDMENT 1, TO SENATE BILL 1006

February 16, 2024 – Offered by Senator Stafsholt.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:
2	${f 1.}$ Page 4, line 19: delete the material beginning with that line and ending with
3	page 5, line 3.
4	2. Page 8, line 6: delete lines 6 to 21 and substitute:
5	"SECTION 24. 29.889 (6) (f) 2. of the statutes is created to read:
6	29.889 (6) (f) 2. a. A person who receives a payment of a crop insurance claim
7	for damage caused by wildlife may receive a payment for a wildlife damage claim that
8	arose from the same growing season for up to the amount of the damage that was not
9	covered by the insurance payment, subject to sub. (7) (b) 4. Except as provided in
10	subd. 2. c., if a person has crop insurance that covers wildlife damage, the amount
11	of a wildlife damage claim payment for crop damage caused by wildlife may not be
12	determined until an insurance claim for the damage is filed and settled.
