SENATE AMENDMENT 1, TO SENATE BILL 325

September 13, 2023 – Offered by Senator Marklein.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:
2	1. Page 5, line 19: delete lines 19 and 20 and substitute:
3	" <u>a. Projects</u> that include <u>at least 25 percent</u> matching funds , <u>and shall give</u>
4	higher priority to projects with more than 25 percent matching funds.".
5	2. Page 6, line 15: delete lines 15 to 20 and substitute:
6	"SECTION 12. 196.504 (2) (c) 1. g. and h. of the statutes are created to read:
7	196.504 (2) (c) 1. g. Projects designed to provide fiber optic Internet service
8	directly to the end user in geographic areas where the cost to deploy fiber optic
9	Internet is below the extremely high cost per location threshold established by this
10	state for the purpose being eligible for federal funding under the broadband, equity,
11	access, and deployment program authorized under 47 USC 1702.
12	h. Projects that affect a geographic area that has actual download speeds of 25
13	megabits per second or lower and upload speeds of 3 megabits per second or lower.".

1	3. Page 8, line 21: after that line insert:
2	"SECTION 16m. Nonstatutory provisions.
3	(1) BROADBAND EXPANSION GRANT PROGRAM. The provisions of the broadband
4	expansion grant program under s. 196.504 do not apply to any grant program created
5	with federal funding received under the broadband, equity, access, and deployment
6	program authorized under 47 USC 1702.".
