## SENATE AMENDMENT 2, TO SENATE BILL 346

October 17, 2023 – Offered by Senators Roys, L. Johnson, Pfaff, Spreitzer, Agard, Carpenter, Hesselbein, Larson and Smith.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:
2	<b>1.</b> Page 2, line 16: delete lines 16 to 19 and substitute:
3	"(2) The department shall solicit and review applications for the grant program
4	under this section and shall award a grant in an amount of no more than \$5,000,000
5	to one organization in each fiscal biennium.
6	(2m) An organization is eligible for the grant if it meets all of the following
7	standards:
8	(a) It operates a financial assistance program for prospective adoptive families.
9	(b) It does not discriminate on the basis of race, sex, sexual orientation, as
10	defined in s. 111.32 (13m), gender, gender identity, national origin, disability, as
11	defined in s. 106.50 (1m) (g), religion, ethnicity, marital status, family status, as
12	defined in s. 106.50 (1m) (k), status as a victim of domestic abuse, sexual assault, or
13	stalking, as defined in s. 106.50 (1m) (u), lawful source of income, age, or ancestry.

(c) If the organization provides pregnancy counseling, it provides counseling
on all options available to a pregnant person, including abortion.".
