## **ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 5,**

## TO SENATE BILL 70

June 29, 2023 – Offered by Representatives VINING, BARE, JOERS, ANDRACA, C. ANDERSON, MADISON, CLANCY, SUBECK, SINICKI, J. ANDERSON, HONG, NEUBAUER, EMERSON, JACOBSON, OHNSTAD, PALMERI, RATCLIFF, CONLEY, SNODGRASS, SHELTON, CABRERA, DRAKE, BALDEH, CONSIDINE, MOORE OMOKUNDE, BILLINGS, GOYKE, STUBBS, MYERS, ORTIZ-VELEZ, RIEMER and SHANKLAND.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the bill, as shown by senate substitute
2	amendment 2, as follows:
3	<b>1.</b> Page 318, line 4: after that line insert:
4	"SECTION 1. 49.46 (1) (a) 1m. of the statutes is amended to read:
5	49.46 (1) (a) 1m. Any pregnant woman whose income does not exceed the
6	standard of need under s. 49.19 (11) and whose pregnancy is medically verified.
7	Eligibility continues to the last day of the month in which the 60th day or, if approved
8	by the federal government, the <u>90th</u> <u>365th</u> day after the last day of the pregnancy
9	falls.
10	<b>SECTION 2.</b> 49.46 (1) (j) of the statutes is amended to read:
11	49.46 (1) (j) An individual determined to be eligible for benefits under par. (a)
12	9. remains eligible for benefits under par. (a) 9. for the balance of the pregnancy and
13	to the last day of the month in which the 60th day or, if approved by the federal

1	government, the <u>90th</u> <u>365th</u> day after the last day of the pregnancy falls without
2	regard to any change in the individual's family income.".
3	<b>2.</b> Page 319, line 3: after that line insert:
4	"SECTION 3. 49.47 (4) (ag) 2. of the statutes is amended to read:
5	49.47 (4) (ag) 2. Pregnant and the woman's pregnancy is medically verified.
6	Eligibility continues to the last day of the month in which the 60th day or, if approved
7	by the federal government, the 90th $\underline{365th}$ day after the last day of the pregnancy
8	falls.
9	<b>SECTION 4.</b> 49.471 (6) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:
10	49.471 (6) (b) A pregnant woman who is determined to be eligible for benefits
11	under sub. (4) remains eligible for benefits under sub. (4) for the balance of the
12	pregnancy and to the last day of the month in which the 60th day or, if approved by
13	the federal government, the <u>90th</u> <u>365th</u> day after the last day of the pregnancy falls
14	without regard to any change in the woman's family income.".
15	<b>3.</b> Page 319, line 12: after that line insert:
16	"SECTION 5. 49.471 (7) (b) 1. of the statutes is amended to read:
17	49.471 (7) (b) 1. A pregnant woman whose family income exceeds 300 percent
18	of the poverty line may become eligible for coverage under this section if the
19	difference between the pregnant woman's family income and the applicable income
20	limit under sub. (4) (a) is obligated or expended for any member of the pregnant
21	woman's family for medical care or any other type of remedial care recognized under
22	state law or for personal health insurance premiums or for both. Eligibility obtained
23	under this subdivision continues without regard to any change in family income for
24	the balance of the pregnancy and to the last day of the month in which the 60th day

or, if approved by the federal government, the 90th 365th day after the last day of the
woman's pregnancy falls. Eligibility obtained by a pregnant woman under this
subdivision extends to all pregnant women in the pregnant woman's family.".
