TO SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 2,
TO SENATE BILL 45**

July 2, 2025 - Offered by Senators HESSELBEIN, SMITH, SPREITZER, DRAKE, L. JOHNSON, ROYS, CARPENTER, DASSLER-ALFHEIM, HABUSH SINYKIN, KEYESKI, LARSON, PFAFF, RATCLIFF and WALL.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** At the appropriate places, insert all of the following:

3 “**SECTION 1.** 609.83 of the statutes is amended to read:

4 **609.83 Coverage of drugs and devices.** Limited service health
5 organizations, preferred provider plans, and defined network plans are subject to
6 ss. 632.853, 632.861, and 632.895 (6)(b), (16t), and (16v).

7 **SECTION 2.** 632.895 (6) (title) of the statutes is amended to read:

8 632.895 **(6)** (title) EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLIES FOR TREATMENT OF DIABETES;
9 INSULIN.

10 **SECTION 3.** 632.895 (6) of the statutes is renumbered 632.895 (6) (a) and
11 amended to read:

1 632.895 (6) (a) Every disability insurance policy ~~which~~ that provides coverage
2 of expenses incurred for treatment of diabetes shall provide coverage for expenses
3 incurred by the installation and use of an insulin infusion pump, coverage for all
4 other equipment and supplies, including insulin or any other prescription
5 medication, used in the treatment of diabetes, and coverage of diabetic self-
6 management education programs. ~~Coverage~~ Except as provided in par. (b),
7 coverage required under this subsection shall be subject to the same exclusions,
8 limitations, deductibles, and coinsurance provisions of the policy as other covered
9 expenses, except that insulin infusion pump coverage may be limited to the
10 purchase of one pump per year and the insurer may require the insured to use a
11 pump for 30 days before purchase.

12 **SECTION 4.** 632.895 (6) (b) of the statutes is created to read:

13 632.895 (6) (b) 1. In this paragraph:

14 a. “Cost sharing” means the total of any deductible, copayment, or
15 coinsurance amounts imposed on a person covered under a disability insurance
16 policy or self-insured health plan.

17 b. “Self-insured health plan” has the meaning given in s. 632.85 (1) (c).

18 2. Every disability insurance policy and self-insured health plan that covers
19 insulin and imposes cost sharing on prescription drugs may not impose cost sharing
20 on insulin in an amount that exceeds \$35 for a one-month supply of insulin.

21 3. Nothing in this paragraph prohibits a disability insurance policy or self-
22 insured health plan from imposing cost sharing on insulin in an amount less than

1 the amount specified under subd. 2. Nothing in this paragraph requires a disability
2 insurance policy or self-insured health plan to impose any cost sharing on insulin.

3 **SECTION 9423. Effective dates; Insurance.**

4 (1) COST-SHARING CAP ON INSULIN. The treatment of ss. 609.83 and 632.895
5 (6) (title), the renumbering and amendment of s. 632.895 (6), and the creation of s.
6 632.895 (6) (b) take effect on the first day of the 4th month beginning after
7 publication.”.
