This bill creates a sum certain appropriation from general purpose revenues to support the integrated business information system under which DOA provides information technology services to state agencies for certain purposes. This bill also renames the system to be called the "enterprise resource planning system".

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 16.971 (2) (cf) of the statutes is amended to read:

16.971 (2) (cf) Implement, operate, maintain, and upgrade an integrated

business information enterprise resource planning system capable of providing

information technology services to all agencies in the areas of accounting, auditing,

payroll and other financial services; procurement; human resources; and other administrative processes. The department may provide information technology services under this subsection to any executive branch agency under s. 16.70 (4). The department may also provide information technology services to any local governmental unit under this subsection.

SECTION 2. 20.505 (1) (fp) of the statutes is created to read:

20.505 (1) (fp) *Enterprise resource planning system; general purpose revenue.* The amounts in the schedule to support the enterprise resource planning system under s. 16.971 (2) (cf). The secretary may transfer moneys appropriated under this paragraph to the appropriation under par. (kd).

SECTION 3. 20.505 (1) (iv) (title) of the statutes is amended to read:

20.505 (1) (iv) (title) Integrated business information Enterprise resource

planning system; nonstate entities.

SECTION 4. 20.505 (1) (kd) of the statutes is amended to read:

20.505 (1) (kd) *Integrated business information Enterprise resource planning*

system. All moneys received from any agency, as defined in s. 16.97 (1m), <u>and all</u> <u>moneys transferred from the appropriation under par. (fp)</u>, for information

technology purposes under s. 16.971 (2) (cf), to be used for those purposes.

SECTION 5. 20.865 (2) (i) (title) of the statutes is amended to read:

20.865 (2) (i) (title) Integrated business information Enterprise resource

<u>planning</u> system; program revenues.
