PRIMARY AND SECONDARY EDUCATION

Under current law, DPI must develop an educator effectiveness evaluation system (EEES). Current law requires school districts and the operator of a charter school that is operated by or under contract with UW-Milwaukee, UW-Parkside, the Milwaukee Area Technical College, or the city of Milwaukee (an independent charter school) to employ the EEES to evaluate teachers and principals on a variety of measures. This bill permits DPI to charge a fee to school districts and independent charter schools to use the EEES developed by DPI. The bill also permits DPI to award grants to school districts to implement an EEES or equivalency evaluation process. The bill creates three new appropriations related to implementing the EEES.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 20.255 (1) (ee) of the statutes is created to read:

20.255 (1) (ee) Educator effectiveness evaluation system. The amounts in the schedule to implement the educator effectiveness evaluation system under s. 115.415.

SECTION 2. 20.255 (1) (ge) of the statutes is created to read:

20.255 (1) (ge) *Educator effectiveness evaluation system; fees.* All moneys received from fees under s. 115.415 (2) to be used for the educator effectiveness evaluation system developed under s. 115.415 (2).

SECTION 3. 20.255 (2) (ek) of the statutes is created to read:

20.255 (2) (ek) Educator effectiveness evaluation system; grants to school

districts. The amounts in the schedule for grants to school districts under s. 115.415 (4).

SECTION 4. 115.415 (2) (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:

115.415 (2) (intro.) The department shall develop an educator effectiveness evaluation system according to the following framework, and may charge a fee to a school district and the governing body of a charter school established under s. 118.40 (2r) to use the system developed under this subsection:

SECTION 5. 115.415 (4) of the statutes is created to read:

115.415 (4) From the appropriation under s. 20.255 (2) (ek), the department may award grants to school districts and the governing body of a charter school established under s. 118.40 (2r) to implement an educator effectiveness evaluation

system developed under sub. (2) or an equivalency process established by rule under sub. (3).
