PRIMARY AND SECONDARY EDUCATION

This bill prohibits the governing body of a virtual charter school from allowing a pupil to start attending the virtual charter school during a semester in which the pupil has had four or more unexcused absences from school.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 118.40 (8) (fm) of the statutes is created to read:

118.40 (8) (fm) *Attendance requirement.* The governing body of a virtual charter school may not allow a pupil to begin attending the virtual charter school during a semester in which the pupil has been absent from a school without an

acceptable excuse under s. 118.15 or 118.16 (4) for part or all of 4 or more days on which the school was held during the school semester.
