PRIMARY AND SECONDARY EDUCATION

The bill eliminates the requirement that, if a child with a disability is attending public school in a nonresident school district under the open enrollment program, the child's individualized education program team must include a person designated by the child's resident school board.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 115.78 (1m) (h) of the statutes is amended to read:

115.78 **(1m)** (h) If the child is attending a public school in a nonresident school district under s. 118.50, ~~118.51~~, or 121.84 (1) (a) or (4), at least one person designated by the school board of the child's school district of residence who has knowledge or special expertise about the child.
