PRIMARY AND SECONDARY EDUCATION

This bill requires DPI to include in the annual accountability reports prepared for schools and school districts additional information about high school pupils, including the number of pupils attending a course through the Course Options or Youth Options programs, the number of pupils participating in a youth apprenticeship, and the number of pupils earning industry-recognized credentials.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 115.385 (1) (d) of the statutes is created to read:

115.385 (1) (d) For a school district and for each high school in that school district, all of the following information:

1. The number and percentage of pupils participating in the program under s. 118.55.

2. The number and percentage of pupils participating in a youth apprenticeship under s. 106.13.

3. The number of community service hours provided by pupils.

4. The number of advanced placement courses offered to and the number of advanced placement credits earned by pupils.

5. The number of pupils earning industry-recognized credentials through a technical education program established by a school board as described in s. 118.33
