Amyotrophic lateral sclerosis grant

Under current law, DHS awards grants for certain community programs. This bill requires DHS to annually award \$250,000 to an organization that supports and provides services to individuals with amyotrophic lateral sclerosis (ALS) to assist individuals with ALS and their families with respite care costs and costs associated with ALS that are not covered by insurance.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 46.48 (36) of the statutes is created to read:

46.48 (36) AMYOTROPHIC LATERAL SCLEROSIS. From the appropriation under s. 20.435 (1) (b), the department shall award \$250,000 in each fiscal year as a grant to

an organization that supports and provides services to individuals with amyotrophic lateral sclerosis for the purposes of assisting individuals diagnosed with amyotrophic lateral sclerosis and their families with the costs of respite care and costs associated with amyotrophic lateral sclerosis that are not covered by insurance.
