Grants to free-standing pediatric teaching hospitals

This bill directs DHS to award grants to free-standing pediatric teaching hospitals to fund programming related to parenting, educational needs of and supports for chronically ill children, and case management for children with asthma. The bill specifies that only free-standing pediatric teaching hospitals for which at least 45 percent of total inpatient days are provided to Medical Assistance recipients are eligible for the grant.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 253.19 of the statutes is created to read:

253.19 Grants to free-standing pediatric teaching hospitals. From the appropriation under s. 20.435 (1) (b), the department shall award grants to

free-standing pediatric teaching hospitals to fund programming related to parenting, educational needs of and supports for chronically ill children, and case management for children with asthma. A free-standing pediatric teaching hospital is eligible for a grant under this section only if the percentage of Medical Assistance recipient inpatient days at the free-standing pediatric teaching hospital calculated under s. 49.45 (3m) (b) 1. a. is greater than 45 percent.
