

ORDER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND FAMILY SERVICES AMENDING AND CREATING RULES

To amend HSS 146.03(9) and (10) and to create HSS 146.03(11), relating to vaccinepreventable diseases.

Analysis Prepared by the Department of Health and Family Services

The U.S. Food and Drug Administration recently approved and licensed the use of a vaccine to protect against varicella, commonly called chickenpox, which is mainly a disease of children.

This rulemaking order adds varicella (chickenpox) to the list of vaccine-preventable diseases in ch. HSS 146, Wis. Adm. Code. This action will permit the Department to purchase varicella virus vaccine with state funding for distribution without charge to school districts and local health departments that request the vaccines for local immunization programs.

The Department's authority to amend and create these rules is found in s. 252.04(1) and (10), Stats. The rules interpret s. 252.04(1), Stats.

SECTION 1. HSS 146.03(9) and (10) are amended to read:

HSS 146.03(9) Rubella (German measles); and

(10) Tetanus.; and

SECTION 2. HSS 146.03(11) is created to read:

HSS 146.03(11) Varicella (chickenpox).

The rules contained in this order shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin Administrative Register, as provided in s. 227.22(2), Stats.
