ORDER OF THE WISCONSIN GAMING BOARD ADOPTING RULES

The Wisconsin Gaming Board approves an order to amend 24.13(1)(d) relating to simulcasting fees.

ANALYSIS PREPARED BY THE WISCONSIN GAMING BOARD

Statutory authority: ss. 561.02 Stats.

Statutes interpreted: ss 562.02 (1) (a) and 562.057(5), Stats.

Summary:

WGC 24.13(1)(d) is amended to reduce the simulcast fees from \$50.00 per performance to \$20.00 per performance.

TEXT OF RULES

SECTION 1. WGC 24.13 (1)(d) is amended to read:

WGC 24.13(1) (d) Submit a <u>minimum simulcast</u> fee of \$15 \$20 for each race performance received from an out-of-state host track. <u>In the event the regulatory costs</u> of simulcasting incurred by the Commission exceeds the assessed fee, the Commission shall increase the simulcast fee equally to each association conducting simulcasting to ensure simulcast fees equal the expenses of regulating simulcasting. The fee shall be paid no later than 48 hours after the conclusion of the race day in which the simulcast performance started, or, if the 48 hour period does not include a business day, on the first business day immediately following the close of the race day. This provision regarding the payment of fees shall not be applicable if the guest track schedules three or fewer races <u>accepts wagers on any race</u> of a race performance from on out-of-state host track.
