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

ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD AMENDING AND CREATING RULES

The Wisconsin Natural Resources Board proposes an order to amend NR 20.13(2)(a) and create NR 20.13(2)(c) relating to ice fishing shelters.

Analysis Prepared by the Department of Natural Resources

Statutory authority: ss. 29.174(2)(a), 29.283(1) and 227.11(2)(a), Stats. Statute interpreted: s. 29.174(2)(a), Stats.

In this order, SECTION 1 amends NR 20.13(2)(a) to refer to an exemption created in Section 2 and to make minor "housekeeping" changes. SECTION 2 creates a rule banning the placement of permanent ice fishing shelters n the Fox river, Brown county, from the dam at DePere downstream to its mouth at the bay of Green Bay. Only temporary shelters on this water are authorized.

SECTION 1. NR 20.13(2)(a) is amended to read:

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1. . . .

NR 20.13(2)(a) Buildings, tents, fish shanties, portable shelters or similar enclosures or shelters may be used on the ice for fishing purposes. The door of any such enclosure or shelter shall be equipped with a latch which will permit the door to be readily opened from the outside at all times while the enclosure or shelter is occupied. All such Except as required under par.(c), all enclosures or shelters shall be removed from the ice on or before March 5 south of highway #64, excluding Green Bay waters, and March 15 north of highway #64 on all waters including other outlying waters. Such shelters shall be removed prior to that time by order of the department or by its agents when they feel that the ice has become unsafe for travel thereon. For any water, the department or its agents may direct that enclosures or shelters be removed by an earlier date if it has reason to believe that the ice has become unsafe for travel.

SECTION 2. NR 20.13(2)(c) is created to read:

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NR 20.13(2)(c) No person may place or use a building, tent, fish shanty, portable shelter or similar enclosure or shelter for fishing purposes on the ice of the Fox river from the DePere dam downstream to the mouth of the river, except when the person is actively using the enclosure or shelter, and all enclosures or shelters shall be removed from the ice daily and when not in use.

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The foregoing rule was approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on January 28, 1998.

The rule shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register as provided in s. 227.22(2)(intro.), Stats.
