ENROLLED JOINT RESOLUTION

Relating to: proclaiming May 2023 as Naturopathic Medicine Month in Wisconsin.

Whereas, naturopathic medicine provides noninvasive, holistic treatments that support the inherent self-healing capacity of the human body and encourage self-responsibility in health care; and

Whereas, naturopathic doctors attend four-year, graduate-level programs with rigorous admissions requirements at institutions that are recognized by the U.S. Department of Education; and

Whereas, naturopathic doctors are especially skilled in treating chronic illnesses, such as diabetes, asthma, autoimmune disorders, and gastrointestinal disorders, because of their focus on whole–body medicine rather than symptom management; and

Whereas, the designation of Naturopathic Medicine Month promotes awareness and recognizes the value of naturopathic medicine and providing safe, effective, and affordable health care; now, therefore, be it

Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That the legislature hereby proclaims May 2023 to be Naturopathic Medicine Month in Wisconsin.
