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STATATION D

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EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 56

WHEREAS, the State of Wisconsin has experienced extensive property loss and damage as a result of disasters including, but not limited to, storms, floods, high waters, wind-driven waters and other catastrophes; and there is a need for special measures designed to aid and accelerate the efforts in those affected areas to reconstruct and rehabilitate the devastated areas; and

WHEREAS, there is the skill, experience and talent in the several Wisconsin Departments to prepare plans to assist in minimizing such property loss and damage in this State; and

WHEREAS, there is within the State government, the Division of Emergency Government, Department of Local Affairs and Development, charged with the responsibility for coordinating all such plans for effective implementation.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, PATRICK J. LUCEY, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and Statutes of this State, do hereby ORDER and DIRECT:

1. That the Administrator of the Division of Emergency Government, in order to more effectively discharge his above referred to duties, is authorized to call upon any department, office, division or agency of the State to supply such assistance, statistical data, program reports and other information as he deems necessary.
