

EXECUTIVE ORDER 20

WHEREAS, the enormous volume of solid waste generated in Wisconsin poses a serious economic and environmental problem for our state; and

WHEREAS, the recycling and resource recovery of solid waste reduces the need for landfills and their associated environmental impact; and

WHEREAS, the recycling the solid waste conserves natural resources and provides a Wisconsin source of raw materials for manufacturers; and

WHEREAS, the resource recovery of solid waste for energy provides an alternative source of renewable energy generated within Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, both recycling and resource recovery creates new employment in the conversion of unwanted waste into useful products and energy;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ANTHONY S. EARL, Governor of Wisconsin, do hereby create, by the authority granted by Wisconsin Statutes s. 14.029, the Governor's Task Force on Solid Waste Recycling with the following provisions:

- The Task Force shall be composed of 15 members appointed by the Governor to serve at his pleasure, 5 of whom shall be legislators and the remainder of whom shall be from the private sector;
- (2) The Task Force shall report to the Governor with recommendations for administrative and legislative initiatives to advance recycling in Wisconsin no later than December 31, 1983;
- (3) The Chairperson of the Task Force shall be Representative Jeffrey Neubauer; and
- (4) The Departments of Administration and Natural Resources shall render whatever assistance is necessary to the Task Force so that it may complete its report by the specified date.
