EXECUTIVE ORDER #27 LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE BUREAU

WHEREAS, public higher education offered by the University of Wisconsin System is a function of the state; and

WHEREAS, the quality of higher education offered by the University of Wisconsin System depends in important part on the quality of its faculty; and

WHEREAS, appropriate compensation levels and practices are an important factor in the recruitment and retention of faculty members;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ANTHONY S. EARL, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to the authority vested in me by Section 14.019 of Wisconsin Statutes, do hereby:

1. Establish the Faculty Compensation Study Committee;

- 2. Provide that the committee shall consist of no more than 16 members appointed by the Governor, upon consultation with the University of Wisconsin Board of Regents, and including at least four members nominated by the Board of Regents;
- 3. Provide that the chairperson shall be appointed by the Governor, upon consultation with the Board of Regents;
- 4. Direct the committee to present to the Governor, Legislature and Board of Regents a written report of its findings and recommendations by March 31, 1984;
- 5. Direct the committee to examine exhaustively the current and historical levels of faculty salaries and other employee compensation, the internal and external salary pay plan practices of the University of Wisconsin and the State of Wisconsin System and the possible funding sources for any recommended changes in compensation;
- 6. Direct the Secretary of the Department of Administration, pursuant to Section 20.505(3)(a) of the Wisconsin Statutes, to provide the committee with sums of money necessary and proper for legitimate travel and operating expenses; and



 Direct the Secretary of the Department of Administration, the Secretary of the Department of Employment Relations,
and the President of the University of Wisconsin System, to provide all necessary staff resources for the committee.
