## EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 34

WHEREAS, the State of Wisconsin has an obligation to promote equality of all its people; and

WHEREAS, Wisconsin's Hispanic residents have faced particular difficulties in achieving equality of opportunity, and society has thereby been deprived of many of their potential contributions; and

WHEREAS, many Hispanic residents of Wisconsin are not employed to the full extent of their capabilities; and problems in many areas contribute to the underutilization of their talents; and

WHEREAS, state government could benefit from the advice of people who are knowledgeable and experienced with regard to the impact of state policies on Hispanics and methods by which its service to these citizens could be improved;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, ANTHONY S. EARL, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the power vested in me by section 14.019, Wisconsin Statutes, do hereby establish

## THE GOVERNOR'S COUNCIL ON HISPANIC AFFAIRS

The Council shall develop positions relative to the issues concerning Hispanics, make recommendations to the Governor, Legislature and departmental secretaries relative to the needs of Hispanics; and develop strategies to implement position(s) taken on the identified issues.

In carrying out this mandate, the Council shall consider recommendations developed by previous reports on Hispanic needs, as well as other state services which are especially important to Hispanics.

Whenever appropriate, the Council shall coordinate its activities with those of other agencies and committees, in order to prevent any duplication of effort in areas of mutual concern.
