



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 48

WHEREAS, an agreement establishing relations of friendship between Wisconsin and Heilongjiang Province of the People's Republic of China was signed by Governor Lee S. Dreyfus and Heilongjiang Governor Chen Lei on October 18, 1982; and

WHEREAS, this agreement stipulates that the two will "promote cooperation and technological exchanges" and will "exchange sports, cultural groups and tourists"; and

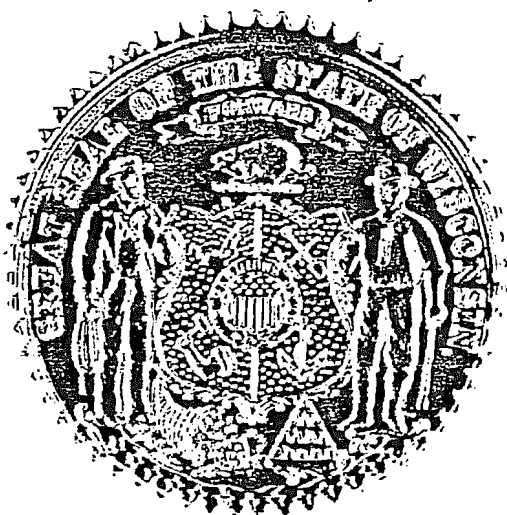
WHEREAS, a group of people has been working in these areas at the Governor's request in an effort to strengthen the relations between Wisconsin and Heilongjiang;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ANTHONY S. EARL, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to the authority vested in me by section 14.019 of Wisconsin Statutes, do hereby:

1. Establish the Wisconsin-Heilongjiang Coordinating Committee;
2. Provide that members shall be appointed by the Governor to serve at his pleasure;
3. Charge the Committee with working with state agencies in facilitating Wisconsin's contributions to the implementation of the agreement;
4. Provide that the Committee shall adopt such rules concerning its operating procedures and organization as it deems appropriate; and
5. Instruct the Secretary of the Department of Administration to provide the Committee with sums of money that are necessary and proper for the legitimate travel and operating expenses of the Committee as provided by the Joint Committee on Finance under section 20.505(3)(a) of the Wisconsin Statutes.
