EXECUTIVE ORDER #186

Relating to Disposal of Surplus or Excess Land

WHEREAS, the sale of surplus property owned by the state generates revenue and provides property tax relief by placing those properties back on the property tax rolls.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to sec. 13.48 (14)(d), Wis. Stats., do wish to include all lands surplus or excess under the jurisdiction of all state agencies and requests, as follows:


- A. That all state agencies provide a listing that identifies location, county, section, town, description, estimated value, and accessibility to roads of all lands owned to the Department of Administration, Division of Facilities Development within the next 180 days.
- B. That any property considered surplus or excess shall be disposed of by the Department of Administration, Division of Facilities Development through an active marketing approach with Realtors located in the area in which the property is located.

The agency owning the surplus or excess lands shall cooperate with the Department of Administration, Division of Facilities Development with the sale of such lands and shall pay any cost in order to consummate the sale, i.e. surveys, permits, etc. with reimbursement from the proceeds of such sales for any costs incurred.


- C. That any net proceeds from the sale of any surplus or excess lands shall be deposited in the states bond redemption fund or in accordance with Wisconsin statutes.
