EXECUTIVE ORDER #263

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flags of the United States and the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for the Memory of Yitzhak Rabin, the Late Prime Minister of the State of Israel

WHEREAS, on November 4, 1995 Yitzhak Rabin, the late Prime Minister of the State of Israel, was assassinated; and

WHEREAS, this senseless and cowardly act of violence robbed the world of a great statesman and peacemaker; and

WHEREAS, Prime Minister Rabin was a close friend to the people of the United States and to all the peace-loving people of the world;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all State buildings and grounds equipped with such flags beginning forthwith until the interment of Yitzhak Rabin.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Wisconsin to be affixed. Done at the Capitol in the City of Madison this fourth day of November in the year one thousand nine hundred and ninety-five.
