EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 13

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for The Honorable Ernest C. Keppler, Late Judge of the Circuit Court of Sheboygan County

WHEREAS, on May 23, 2001, the Honorable Ernest C. Keppler passed away; and


WHEREAS, Judge Keppler was elected to the Wisconsin State Assembly in 1942; and

WHEREAS, Judge Keppler served in the Wisconsin State Senate from 1960 to 1978; and


WHEREAS, Judge Keppler was elected circuit court judge of Sheboygan County in 1979 and served for six years; and

WHEREAS, after his retirement, Judge Keppler continued to serve as a reserve judge;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, SCOTT McCALLUM, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on Tuesday, May 29, 2001, and ending at sundown on that date.
