EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 14

Proclamation of a State of Emergency


WHEREAS, severe thunderstorms and high winds occurred in the State of Wisconsin on or about June 11, 2001; and

WHEREAS, such severe thunderstorms and high winds caused extensive damage in the State of Wisconsin amounting to a natural disaster; and

WHEREAS, this natural disaster affected Winnebago and Outagamie Counties;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, SCOTT McCALLUM, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of this state, and specifically by Section 166.03 (1)(b) 1 of the Wisconsin Statutes, do hereby:

1. Proclaim that a State of Emergency exists in Winnebago and Outagamie Counties; and
2. Direct all agencies of the State of Wisconsin to assist Winnebago and Outagamie Counties in recovering from this natural disaster.
