

EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 26

Relating to Executive Order No. 23, the Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff Due to Terrorist Attacks on the United States

WHEREAS, on September 11, 2001, a series of vicious and cowardly terrorist attacks claimed the lives of numerous innocent and unsuspecting United States citizens; and

WHEREAS, President George W. Bush issued and ordered that the flags be flown at half-staff as a mark of respect for those that lost their lives to these vicious attacks; and

WHEREAS, the people of the State of Wisconsin offer their continued prayers and sympathies to all persons and families affected by this tragedy; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, SCOTT McCALLUM, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags in accordance with the President of the United States' order.

By the authority vested in me as President of the United States by the Constitution and the laws of the United States of America, and in order to extend the display of the flag at half-staff as a mark of respect for the victims of the terrorist attacks on Tuesday, September 11, 2001, it is hereby ordered that Proclamation 7461 of September 11, 2001, is amended by deleting in the first sentence the words "Sunday, September 16" and inserting in their place the words "Saturday, September 22."

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand this fourteenth day of September, in the year of our Lord two thousand one, and of the Independence of the United States of America the two hundred and twenty-sixth.
