

EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 36

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flags of the United States and the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for the Honorable Henry S. Reuss.

WHEREAS, Congressman Henry S. Reuss passed away at that age of 89 January 12, 2002; and

WHEREAS, Congressman Reuss served the Fifth District of Wisconsin in the United States House of Representatives from 1955 to 1983; and

WHEREAS, Congressman Reuss devoted many years of his life to public service;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Scott McCallum, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all State buildings and grounds equipped with such flags Wednesday, January 16, 2002.
