

EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 59

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for United States Senator Paul Wellstone Who Lost His Life in a Plane Crash in Minnesota

WHEREAS, on October 25, 2002 there was a plane crash in Northern Minnesota; and

WHEREAS, United States Senator Paul Wellstone of Minnesota was among the passengers who perished; and


WHEREAS, Senator Wellstone faithfully and honorably served the people of the United States; and

WHEREAS, President Bush has ordered that the flag of the United States shall be flown at half-staff on Friday, October 25, 2002 and Saturday, October 26, 2002 as a mark of respect for the memory of Senator Wellstone;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, SCOTT McCALLUM, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning today at 2:00 PM, October 25, 2002, and ending at sundown on October 26, 2002.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Wisconsin to be affixed. Done at the Capitol in the City of Madison this twenty-fifth day of October in the year two thousand two.
