EXECUTIVE ORDER # 14

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for EMT Merlin Casey of the Mount Horeb Emergency Medical Service

WHEREAS, on May 10, 2003, EMT Merlin Casey died while responding to an emergency medical call in Dane County; and

WHEREAS, EMT Merlin Casey served the people of Mount Horeb and the people of Wisconsin with distinction and honor; and

WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of EMT Merlin Casey; and


WHEREAS, EMT Merlin Casey will be laid to rest on Thursday, May 15, 2003; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on Thursday, May 15, 2003, and ending at sundown on that date.
