**Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Sergeant 1<sup>st</sup> Class Dan Henry Gabrielson of the United States Army Reserve Who Lost His Life During Operation Iraqi Freedom**


**WHEREAS**, on July 9, 2003, Sgt. 1<sup>st</sup> Class Dan Henry Gabrielson of Frederic, Wisconsin, a member of the United States Army Reserve, 652<sup>nd</sup> Engineer Company, was killed when his convoy was attacked in Iraq; and

**WHEREAS**, Sgt. 1<sup>st</sup> Class Dan Henry Gabrielson faithfully and honorably served the people of the State of Wisconsin and the people of the United States; and




**NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE**, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on **Wednesday, July 23, 2003** and ending at sunset at that date.
