
**WHEREAS**, on Thursday, November 13, 2003, Deputy Richard A. Meyer died in an automobile accident while on duty in Winnebago County; and

**WHEREAS**, Deputy Richard A. Meyer served the people of Winnebago County and the people of Wisconsin with distinction and honor; and


**WHEREAS**, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Deputy Richard A. Meyer; and

**WHEREAS**, Deputy Richard A. Meyer will be laid to rest on Monday, November 17, 2003; and


**NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE**, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on **Monday, November 17, 2003**, and ending at sundown on that date.
