EXECUTIVE ORDER # 30


Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for 2nd Lieutenant Jeremy L. Wolfe of the United States Army Who Lost His Life During Operation Iraqi Freedom

WHEREAS, on November 15, 2003, a helicopter crash occurred in Iraq killing 2nd Lieutenant Jeremy L. Wolfe of Menomonie, Wisconsin, a member of the 4th Battalion, 101st Aviation Regiment, 101st Airborne Division; and


WHEREAS, 2nd Lieutenant Jeremy L. Wolfe faithfully and honorably served the people of the State of Wisconsin and the people of the United States; and

WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of 2nd Lieutenant Jeremy L. Wolfe in this tragic accident;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on Wednesday, November 26, 2003, and ending at sundown on that date.
