

EXECUTIVE ORDER # 33


Relating to a Special Election for the Seventeenth Assembly District

WHEREAS, the Honorable G. Spencer Coggs, submitted his resignation as a State Representative for the Seventeenth Assembly District, effective November 25, 2003;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Jim Doyle, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to section 8.50(4) of the Wisconsin Statutes, order that a special election be held on Tuesday, January 27, 2004 to fill the vacancy in the Seventeenth Assembly District. A description of the boundaries of the Seventeenth Assembly District as created in the combined cases of *Baumgart et al. v. Wendelberger*, Case No. 01-C-0121 (E.D. Wis. 2002) and *Jensen et al. v. Wendelberger*, Case No. 02-C-0366 (E.D. Wis. 2002) are set out in the 2001-02 Wisconsin Statutes following section 4.005. The term for the Seventeenth Assembly District will expire on the first Monday in January, 2005. If a primary is necessary, it shall be held on Tuesday, December 30, 2003. Circulation of nomination papers for candidates may begin on Tuesday, November 25, 2003 and nomination papers may be filed no later than 5:00 P.M., December 2, 2003 in the office of the State Elections Board. This election shall be held, conducted, canvassed and returned in accordance with law.
