
WHEREAS, on Friday, March 7, 2003, Adams County Sheriff's Deputy Michael Shannon was killed in the line of duty; and

WHEREAS, Deputy Michael Shannon served the people of Adams and the people of Wisconsin with distinction and honor; and


WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Deputy Michael Shannon;

WHEREAS, Deputy Michael Shannon will be laid to rest on Tuesday, March 11, 2003;


