### EXECUTIVE ORDER # 8

**Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Major Kevin Nave of the United States Marine Corps Who Lost His Life During Operation Iraqi Freedom**

**WHEREAS**, on March 26, 2003, a vehicle accident occurred in Iraq killing Major Kevin Nave of Port Washington, Wisconsin, a member of the 1<sup>st</sup> Marine Division, 5<sup>th</sup> Marines, 3<sup>rd</sup> Battalion; and


**WHEREAS**, Major Kevin Nave faithfully and honorably served the people of the State of Wisconsin and the people of the United States; and

**WHEREAS**, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Major Kevin Nave in this tragic accident; and


**NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE**, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags commencing forthwith until sundown on Wednesday, April 2, 2003.
