Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Private First Class Sean M. Schneider of the United States Army Who Lost His Life During Operation Iraqi Freedom


WHEREAS, on March 29, 2004, Private First Class Sean M. Schneider of Janesville, Wisconsin, a member of the United States Army, Company A, 115th Forward Support Battalion, was killed in Iraq; and

WHEREAS, Private First Class Sean M. Schneider provided faithful and honorable service to the people of the State of Wisconsin and the people of the United States; and

WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Private First Class Sean M. Schneider; and

WHEREAS, Private First Class Sean M. Schneider will be laid to rest on Wednesday, April 7, 2004;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on Wednesday, April 7, 2004, and ending at sunset on that date.
