

EXECUTIVE ORDER # 50


Relating to the Extension of Eligibility to Receive Pay and Benefits under Wis. Stat. § 230.315

WHEREAS, Wis. Stat. § 230.315 authorizes the Governor to extend, for up to two (2) years, the eligibility to receive the pay and benefits provided thereunder to employees of the State of Wisconsin (the "State") who are activated to serve on military duty in the U.S. armed forces or in the U.S. public health service; and

WHEREAS, there are State employees who have been so activated at various times whose initial eligibility for said pay and benefits has expired or will soon expire; and

WHEREAS, extending the differential pay benefit to the full extent permitted under Wis. Stat. § 230.315 will ensure that State employees and their families are not financially penalized while these brave men and women serve their country in Iraq, Afghanistan and elsewhere;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Jim Doyle, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, do hereby extend the eligibility to receive the pay and benefits provided under Wis. Stat. § 230.315, for each employee of the State activated to serve in the U.S. armed forces or the U.S. public health service. This benefit shall be for up to two (2) years from: (a) January 1, 2003, if the employee was activated on or prior thereto; or (b) the date of the activation if subsequent to January 1, 2003.
