EXECUTIVE ORDER # 51


Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Peace Officers Who Have Given Their Lives in the Line of Duty

WHEREAS, peace officers throughout the State of Wisconsin place themselves in grave danger on a daily basis to protect and serve the citizens of this great state; and


WHEREAS, it is important and appropriate that the people of Wisconsin pause to remember peace officers who have given their lives in the line of duty; and

WHEREAS, on May 18, 2004, at a ceremony at the Sheriff's Office Training Academy Memorial Garden, in the City of Franklin, the State of Wisconsin will honor the peace officers of this state who have given their lives in the line of duty; and


NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and Laws of Wisconsin, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin located in the County of Milwaukee beginning at sunrise on May 18, 2004, and ending at sunset on that date.
