Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Specialist Justin Linden of the Army's National Guard Who Lost His Life During Operation Iraqi Freedom

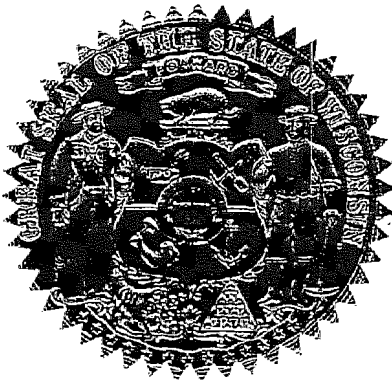
WHEREAS, on June 4, 2004, Specialist Justin Linden, a member of the Army National Guard, 2nd Battalion, 162nd Infantry Regiment was killed in Baghdad, Iraq; and

WHEREAS, Specialist Justin Linden provided faithful and honorable service to the people of the State of Wisconsin and the people of the United States; and

WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Specialist Justin Linden; and

WHEREAS, a memorial service will be held for Specialist Justin Linden on Saturday, June 19, 2004;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on **Saturday, June 19, 2004**, and ending at sunset on that date.
