
**WHEREAS**, on Sunday, September 26, 2004, Ephraim Assistant Fire Chief Bill Weborg died while responding to a fire call; and

**WHEREAS**, Assistant Fire Chief Bill Weborg served the people of the City of Ephraim with distinction and honor as a member of the Ephraim Fire Department for 25 years; and


**WHEREAS**, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Assistant Fire Chief Bill Weborg; and

**WHEREAS**, Assistant Fire Chief Bill Weborg will be laid to rest on Thursday, September 30, 2004;


**NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE**, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on **Thursday, September 30, 2004** and ending at sunset on that date.
