EXECUTIVE ORDER # 105

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Specialist Eric Poelman of the United States Army Who Lost His Life During Operation Iraqi Freedom

WHEREAS, on June 5, 2005, Specialist Eric Poelman, a member of 3rd Squadron, 3rd Armored Cavalry Regiment, United States Army, was killed during enemy action in Iraq; and

WHEREAS, Specialist Eric Poelman provided faithful and honorable service to the people of the State of Wisconsin and the people of the United States; and


WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Specialist Eric Poelman; and

WHEREAS, Specialist Eric Poelman will be laid to rest on Monday, June 13, 2005;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on **June 13, 2005**, and ending at sunset on that date.
