EXECUTIVE ORDER # 123

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Lance Corporal Ryan Nass of the United States Marine Corps Who Lost His Life During Operation Enduring Freedom


WHEREAS, on September 3, 2005, Lance Corporal Ryan Nass, a member of 2nd Battalion, 3rd Marine Regiment, 3rd Marine Division, III Marine Expeditionary Force, United States Marine Corps, lost his life while serving in Afghanistan; and

WHEREAS, Lance Corporal Ryan Nass provided faithful and honorable service to the people of the State of Wisconsin and the people of the United States; and


WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Lance Corporal Ryan Nass; and

WHEREAS, Lance Corporal Ryan Nass will be laid to rest on Saturday, September 10, 2005;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on **September 10, 2005**, and ending at sunset on that date.
