Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Lance Corporal Nicholas Anderson of the United States Marine Corps Who Lost His Life During Operation Enduring Freedom


WHEREAS, on March 13, 2006, Lance Corporal Nicholas Anderson, a member of 1st Battalion, 3rd Marine Regiment, 3rd Marine Division, United States Marine Corps, lost his life while serving on active duty in Afghanistan; and

WHEREAS, Lance Corporal Nicholas Anderson provided faithful and honorable service to the people of the State of Wisconsin and the people of the United States; and


WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Lance Corporal Nicholas Anderson; and

WHEREAS, Lance Corporal Nicholas Anderson will be laid to rest on Thursday, March 23, 2006;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on **March 23, 2006**, and ending at sunset on that date.
