EXECUTIVE ORDER # 151


Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Former United States Representative Gillespie V. "Sonny" Montgomery

WHEREAS, on May 12, 2006, former United States Representative Sonny Montgomery passed away at the age of eighty-five; and

WHEREAS, Sonny Montgomery served with distinction in the United States House of Representatives from 1967-1997, serving as chairman of the House Committee on Veterans' Affairs from 1981-1994; and


WHEREAS, the President has directed that the flag of the United States be lowered to half-staff at all public buildings and grounds in honor of Sonny Montgomery on the day of his interment;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on **Tuesday, May 16, 2006**, and ending at sunset on that date.
